

## WORLD HUNGER SUNDAY APPEAL

Zion's World Hunger Sunday is observed during the Advent season, the beginning of the Christian Calendar, when we reflect on Jesus' coming into this world as a Babe. World Hunger Sunday gives us an opportunity to join forces at – home and overseas – to live out God's vision of a world without hunger; and it marks a new beginning in our lives, as we wait and hope and pray for the coming of a Savior.

Advent is a time to take off the habits and attitudes that keep us in darkness, separating us from God. December 6, 1982 was designated as the first World Hunger Sunday and, thereafter, missionaries throughout our denomination observe World Hunger Sunday. Programs and activities are planned to increase awareness. The objective of World Hunger Sunday is to help in a spiritual way by sharing and giving of our monetary resources to help relieve the suffering of the hungry. Funds can be contributed any Sunday in December as it is Zion's World Hunger Action Month. We are "*Laborers with Christ as His instruments for feeding the Hungry.*" Let us partner with others to **STOP HUNGER NOW!**
